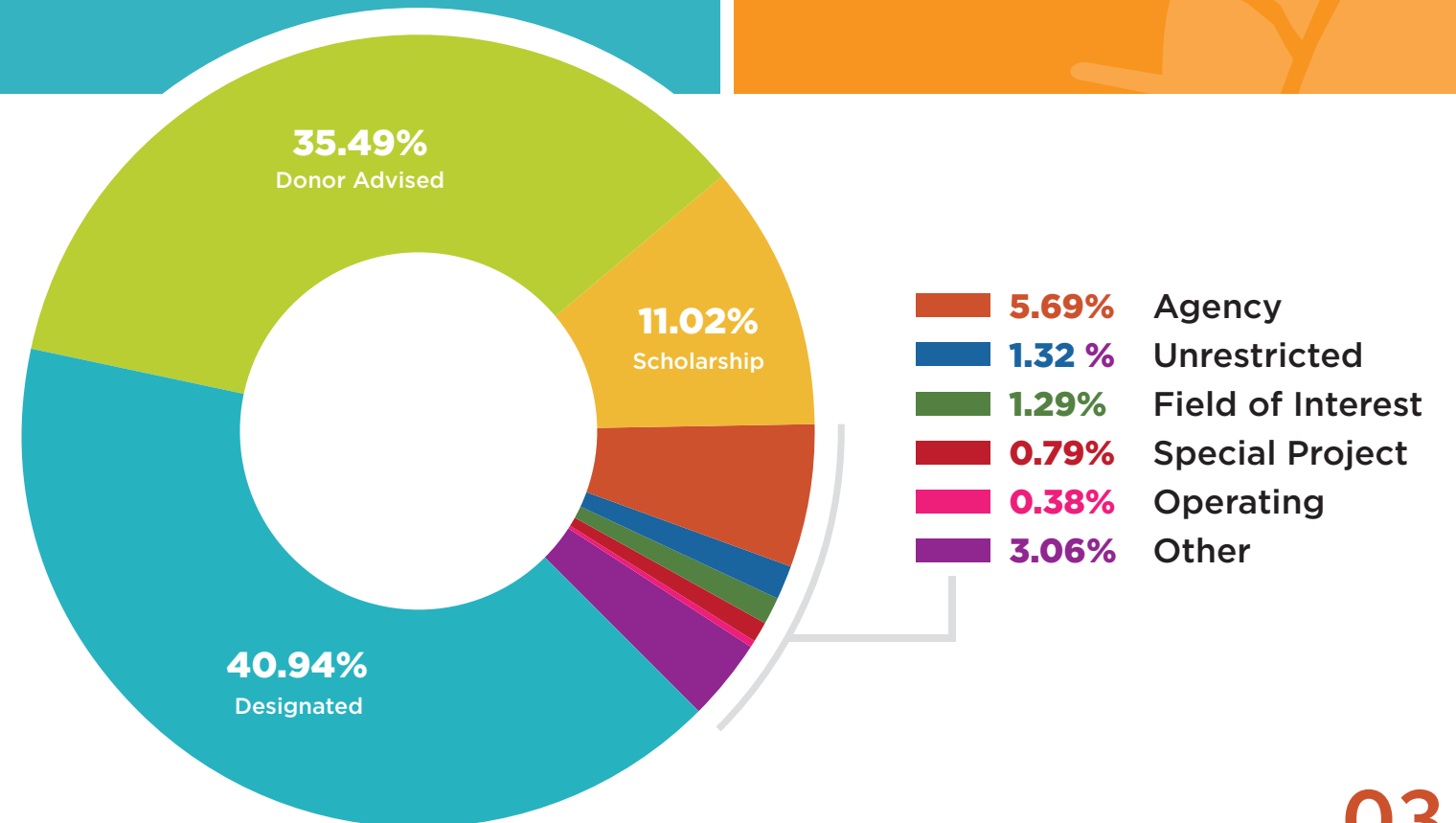

In a rural region like ours, the school yard, turf, court, or library isn't just a place for learning; it's a lifeline for connection, growth, and opportunity.

Each of these funds represents a different approach to giving—whether it's community-based, family-led, or corporate—but together they tell a unified story. A story of neighbors investing in neighbors. A story of hope that a child in a small-town classroom today may one day lead the Valley forward. A story that reminds us education is not a luxury, but a shared responsibility.

At the Community Foundation for the Ohio Valley, that role is reflected in the giving spirit of our donors. Education remains the largest area of support across our eight-county service region, with nearly \$650,000 distributed this past year to strengthen learning in many forms. Some gifts ensure schools have the resources to keep pace with modern needs. Others support libraries, early childhood programs, or afterschool opportunities. Each gift is unique, yet they all share a single purpose: to keep education at the center of our community.

"Education opens doors in ways nothing else can," says CFOV Executive Director Susie Nelson. "When we strengthen opportunities for learning, we don't just impact students—we impact families, neighborhoods, and our entire region."

Some are meant to last forever, others to meet an immediate need. But all reflect a common hope—that every person, no matter their circumstance, has the chance to learn, grow, and thrive here in the Ohio Valley.



Take the Stealey Community Fund, which continues to support schools in Tyler County year after year, reinforcing the idea that education doesn't just shape students—it sustains whole communities. The St. Clairsville Public Library Foundation Fund ensures that in Belmont County, access to books and programs will remain a cornerstone for residents of every age. Families like the Miller's (Miller Family Fund) see education as a lasting legacy, establishing funds that extend opportunities for generations

As CFOV looks back on another year of record investment in education, the story is not simply about dollars distributed. It is about how our community sees education as the bridge between where we are today and where we want to be tomorrow. It is about honoring the legacy of those who gave before us while inspiring the generosity of those yet to come.

And most of all, it is about what makes the Ohio Valley strong: the people who know that when we invest in learning, we invest in possibility.

LEGACIES OF LEARNING:

The Goodman and Lando Funds



Education has the power to change lives, and for two families in the Ohio Valley, creating tutoring funds has been a meaningful way to honor loved ones while giving local students the support they need to succeed.

For Mary Lou Goodman, the creation of the John Goodman Tutoring Fund was a continuation of her late husband's values. "John always felt that it was important, especially for local kids, who maybe have not always had the opportunities," she said. "Education is really important up to fifth grade. If you didn't get it then, you may not." The fund provides tutoring for kindergarten through fifth grade students in the St. Clairsville School District, with sessions scheduled around the bus schedule so transportation is never a barrier. Teachers report the program is already helping children improve in areas like math. "It's just really important—if you don't get the basics of math and reading, it's really hard to catch up," Mary Lou added. "This gives them their catching-up time. And that was important to John."

The Charles and Roslyn Lando Fund was born from a similar belief. "My husband came from Bellaire, Ohio," Roslyn explained. "There were a couple of young, good kids over there who needed tutoring. They were excellent athletes...but they couldn't get to school because they didn't have early childhood education. So, he started paying for tutors for them." After Charles passed, Roslyn carried his vision forward, establishing a tutoring fund in 2013 that supports Ohio County students. Over the years, the program has grown to include more grades and reach additional schools. "I was really happy to do that," Roslyn said. "He felt strongly that public school children needed to be helped if they couldn't get everything they needed during school hours—and of course I agree with him."

Both funds reflect a shared understanding: when children fall behind academically, the right support at the right time can change their entire path. Tutoring not only builds skills but also confidence, giving students the chance to thrive both in and out of the classroom.

For both families, the impact is clear. Tutoring can be the difference-maker for children who might otherwise struggle, and their generosity ensures that students across the Ohio Valley have a stronger foundation for the future.

OPENING DOORS THROUGH EXPOSURE:

HBCU Tours Expand Horizons for Local Students



For nearly two decades, Cultural Diversity and Community Outreach Director at the YWCA Wheeling, Ron Scott, dreamed of creating a program to connect local students with Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs). Two years ago, with support from the Community Foundation for the Ohio Valley through the Mountain Heritage Fund (a partnership with the Claude Worthington Benedum Foundation), Elizabeth S. Hess-Gebhard Fund, and the Hess Family Fund, that dream became a reality.

"It's been something I've wanted to do for almost 20 years," Scott said. "The reasoning behind the whole thing, I just wanted exposure to HBCUs. The only way to really start a pipeline from the Valley to HBCUs is to get students some kind of exposure."

Men of Change launched annual HBCU Tours during spring break, giving local students the opportunity to travel, visit campuses, and immerse themselves in Black history and culture. The first trip brought 35 students and chaperones to Atlanta, home to four HBCUs within walking distance. The following year, participation grew to 45.

"The response from parents and students was 100% all for it," Scott shared. "They wanted to know how to get their kids there. For students, it was completely free thanks to the foundation's support and some additional community contributions."

Students toured campuses including Clark Atlanta University, Morehouse College, and Spelman College, while also visiting African American museums along the way. A stop at West Virginia State University, an HBCU closer to home, gave students a red-carpet welcome

that included a campus tour, a meal, and a Q&A with the university president.

The tours go beyond seeing colleges. Students also connect with alumni and community members. One highlight came when Wheeling native Nick Banks, now living in Atlanta, hosted the group at his home. "He invited all Wheeling natives in Atlanta to come over," Scott said. "He told the students, 'Get out of the Valley, but not to leave it—bring something back.' That message really stuck."

To top it off, the program is already creating a tangible impact. "We got our first student who applied and was accepted to an HBCU because of the trip," Scott said. "She visited Clark Atlanta, loved it, and even though she had missed the deadline, she applied for spring admission. That's the goal—to create a pipeline where students not only see these schools, but picture themselves there."

Looking ahead, Scott hopes to expand the program to include sophomores and juniors, giving students more time to consider HBCUs as an option. The next tour is planned for Washington, D.C., with stops at Howard University and the Smithsonian museums.

"I really think we're this close to making this pipeline possibility happen," Scott reflected. "These trips show students a different culture, a different atmosphere, and let them see what's possible."

HOPE IN A HURRY: RVHF Donates \$50K to Displaced EORH Workers



The funding provided critical support for families living paycheck to paycheck. Gas cards helped workers get to job interviews, daycare assistance ensured parents could continue working, and financial support covered essentials such as rent, utilities, and even professional costs like switching nursing licenses to West Virginia. "People weren't just asking for money—they needed someone to listen, to understand. Sometimes the call itself was as important as the assistance," Stephen added.

For the displaced workers, the relief was more than financial—it was deeply personal. Many had devoted decades to the hospital and suddenly felt vulnerable and uncertain. "We took care of our family," said Kris Molnar, River Valley Health Fund board member. "These were people who gave decades of service to our community, and stepping in to support them was exactly what we were meant to do." She continued, "It reminded us why this fund exists. When people face the unthinkable, they need to know their community will stand beside them." Reflecting on the speed of the response, Molnar added, "Being able to approve the grant so quickly meant families didn't have to wait for help—they could get immediate relief when they needed it most."

Several families who received support later returned to give back once they found new employment, a gesture that highlighted the lasting impact of community generosity. Stephen reflected on the experience and the organizations' long-term collaboration: "Our partnership with CFOV makes responses like this possible. Because we already have a trusted relationship, we can move quickly and efficiently, ensuring help gets to the people who need it most, exactly when they need it." She added, "This was a crisis none of us could have predicted, but thanks to the River Valley Health Fund, we were able to give people hope in their darkest moment."

On March 20, 2025, East Ohio Regional Hospital in Martins Ferry abruptly closed its doors, leaving hundreds of employees suddenly without jobs or paychecks. Many had already worked weeks without receiving their pay, making the closure even more devastating for families who had long relied on steady employment at the hospital. The news shook the community and created immediate hardship for families who had long relied on steady employment at the hospital.

Recognizing the urgency, the River Valley Health Fund at the Community Foundation for the Ohio Valley, stepped in with a \$50,000 grant to support displaced workers. The fund advisors approved the funding within 24 hours, allowing United Way of the Upper Ohio Valley to distribute aid immediately. Families could address urgent needs and stabilize their lives. "We were able to help every single person who called us," said Staci Stephen, executive director of United Way. "That doesn't happen often. And to see the relief in people's voices—it meant everything."

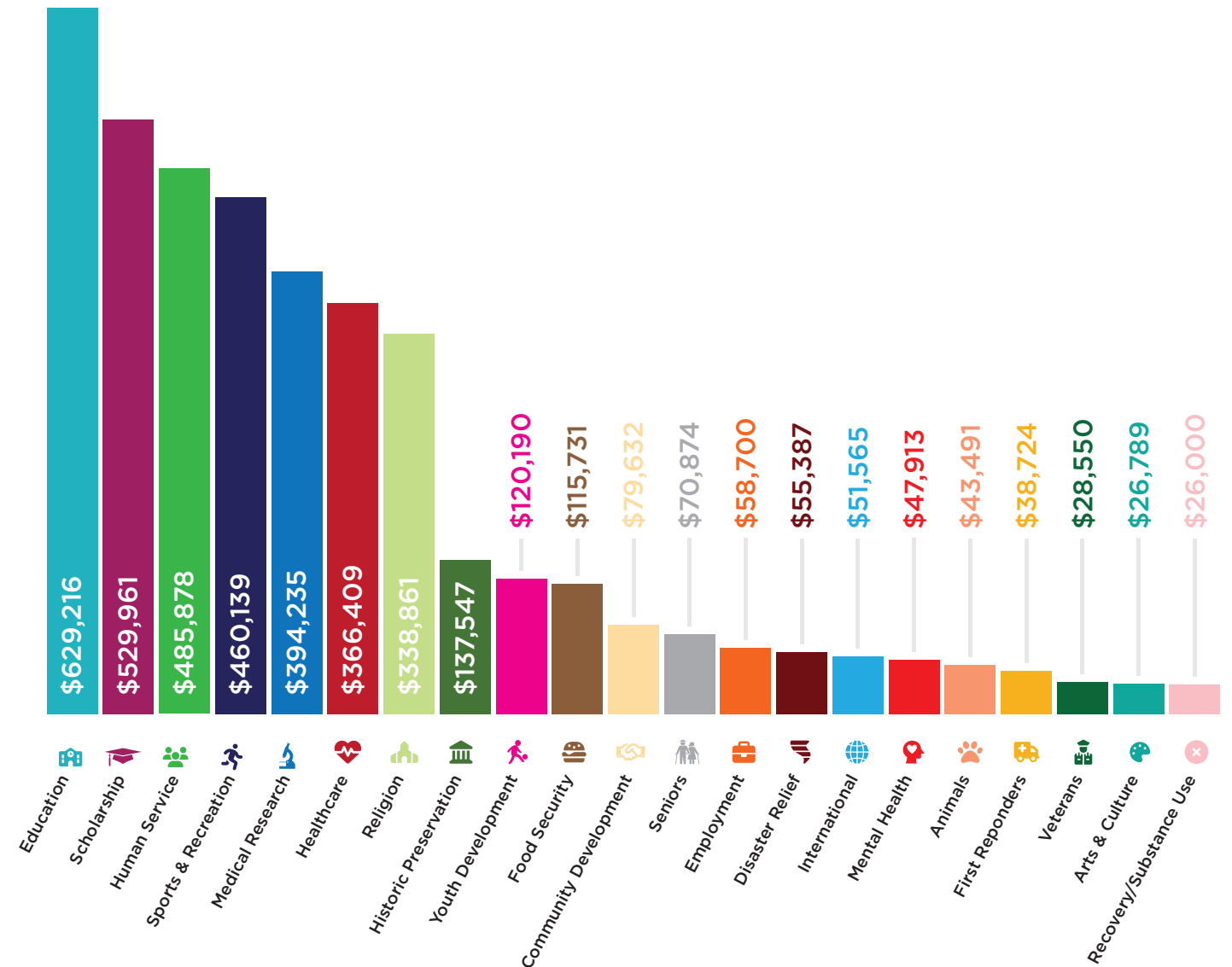
